Conditions / Rules:

1. To enter you must be an introductory or Full Member of ESNZ, or pay \$10 casual member day fee (per day), you can do this when entering online.
2. All classes will be run under the Rules and Regulations of the ESNZ and DNZ. Please verse yourself with DNZ rules and regulations. Go to www.dressagenz.co.nz and click on 'Rules & Regulations'. 'The most fundamental rule - Stay 10 metres back from all sides of the arenas at all times.
3. Bridle numbers or back numbers must be worn when riding and ID Tags on at all other times.
4. Rider Assistance - All local riders. Failure to show up for your nominated task may result in refusal of future entries.
5. The draw will be emailed competitors that enter via on-line entries and will also be on Nelson Dressage website – www.nelsondressage.com
6. A maximum of three tests per day per combination. If riding more than one horse/pony a maximum of two tests per day per combination.
7. Separate pony classes will only be held if there are four entries or more in graded classes Level 1 to Level 2, otherwise ponies and horses will be combined.
8. Graded horses and ponies must be currently registered with the ESNZ and graded riders must be financial members at the time of entry. Graded horses and rider registrations must be current until Monday 14th January 2018
9. Graded horses/ponies may only compete in their current grade or above. Combinations can only enter one ** class. Level 2 rider's can ride in either class 40^ or 41^, cannot ride in both.
10. Prize Money will only be paid out on scores of 57% or higher for L1-L5 & on scores of 55% or higher for L6 & above.
11. Prize money will be paid by electronic banking please provide your bank details on your entry form or email treasurer@nelsondressage.com
12. The OC reserves the right to alter, change or delete any part of this schedule at any time with all due notice being given to concerned parties.
13. Cancellations will be posted on the website by 7am. Event will be held unless conditions extreme.
14. Scratchings – Please notify Event Secretary & send in the withdrawl form. Early Scratching – a full refund is made to rider's scratching by 6pm TEN days before the competition starts (excluding online fee). All requests must be made in writing to the event secretary. Late Scratching – Refunds less 20% will be made with a vet or doctors certificate, or at the discretion of the OC (excluding online/manual entry fee). Apply in writing within 14 days of the competition to the event secretary. **Please take all your rubbish home, and put left over hay and manure from the yards and parking area in the manure bins provided onsite.**
15. Dogs are welcome - Please keep dogs on leads at all times, **THEY MUST NOT BE** around the arenas or club rooms during the competition.
16. During the competition please do not have any horses being led or grazed around the arenas.
17. Please do not enter the Warm Up Arena on foot.
18. Young children to be supervised at all times, do not allow children to play in the arenas at any time.
19. The area between the warm up arena and competition arena (behind the judge's cars) is a quiet place for riders to move from one arena to the other. Please be mindful of the judges needing to concentrate, therefore keeping noise to the minimum.
20. No parking of floats/trucks adjacent to the arenas.
21. Please do not use picnic tables to mount, a mounting block is provided next to the warm up arena.
22. At the "A" end of the arenas please refrain from cantering and stay 10m away from wooden railing. This is a shared area for spectators and horses entering and leaving the competition arenas.

Nelson Dressage Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct is for all Dressage Nelson competitors and their supporters, family, grooms, owners etc.

1. To ensure at all times the safety of your horse.
2. To ensure your horse is fed and watered and covered in an appropriate manner for the duration of the event.
3. Anyone seen abusing their horse will be asked to leave the ground. Nelson Dressage officials will use the notification of the official warning system enforced by Equestrian Sports NZ

Code of Conduct for competitors

1. To at all times show respect and be courteous to all members of committee and to other competitors and spectators.
2. We are a public group insofar that public can and do attend our competitions. You are expected to not bring the Nelson Dressage Committee into disrepute, by outward displays of verbal outcries/ abuse, disrespect to competitors, judges, officials or spectators.
3. The use of social media is an area where we expect the same rules apply as above. Please see ESNZ guidelines for more information on social media use.

Riders have a responsibility to horses and humans to act in accordance with the above guidelines.

The six main notifications which can denote an official warning are:

ABUSE of Horse

Safety to others.

Incorrect behaviour,

ABUSE disregard of officials,

Dangerous riding,

Non compliance of rules - All ESNZ and DNZ rules apply at all times.



NELSON DRESSAGE OFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL FORM

- Please use this form when applying for refund of entries, no refunds will be considered unless this form is sent in.
- To be eligible for a full refund (excluding online entry fee), notification of withdrawal must be received by 6pm TEN days prior to the event.
- Any withdrawals after this time must be accompanied by a Vet, Doctor or Farriers certificate, or at the OC's discretion. All late scratching will be refund due less 20% (excluding online entry fee)
- Any refund requests must be sent to the event secretary Anna Terrell (entries@nelsondressage.com) within 14 days of the event
- **Please note** – all refunds will need to be approved by committee first, so the refund will not be immediate.
